Overview

The Plan of Study Grid is a type of table used to display a suggested sequence of required courses for majors, minors, certificates, etc.

Plan of Study Grid fields allow editors the ability to better describe individual courses.

Courses in a Plan of Study Grid are linked to PeopleSoft in order to provide immediate access to course information.

A Plan of Study Grid provides information in a pre-formatted table structure. It is different from a Course List in that it articulates course sequencing.
